Nordic Fablab Network Bootcamp 2023.

9th of January – 13th of January 2023.

It is with great pleasure that we are able to invite you all to the annual bootcamp.

We live in a world of unrest, high inflation, and a pressing climate crisis. Therefore, the theme during the week will be on reinventing new by using natural and local materials. We will, among other things, introduce you to materials such as sheep wool, horns, and seaweed. Materials that have been used in the household for many hundreds of years, but often today are discarded or burned as waste. We will give you a hands-on learning experience with some of the materials and after you will be able to use them for multiple purposes. Intentionally we can use the opportunity to think new, and experiment with these materials using technologies here in the lab.

The bootcamp will include preplanned workshops from participating members from the network. With space in between to work in the lab with your own initiatives.

Shortly after this invitation is sent out, I will make a question round in the network, whether there is anyone who would like to host a workshop or give a presentation during your stay. Feel free to take some time already, to consider if you have something that you would like to offer. The broader topics, the better we can make sure, there is something interesting for everyone. Examples, but not exclusively, could be Mold&Cast, build a machine from scratch, creativity workshops, CAD teaching etc.

The sooner we plan something together, the easier it is to get additional materials, if needed. As there is a long delivery time here to the Faroes. Notedly there will naturally also be room in the program for spontaneous initiatives!

Practically speaking, materials, accommodation, lunch, and dinner are included in the bootcamp price. Accommodation is reserved at the Sport College student dormitory, where there is room for 48 people, divided into 2 persons per room. If you prefer a single room, or other type of housing, it is immediately at your own additional expenses. Besides breakfast, if you wish to eat at one of the other eateries in the city, it is also at your own expense. More information regarding accommodation will be provided.
